Licensure exams: See *Early Childhood Major sheet for required licensure exams*. These exams are required for the license, but NOT for the major. As of March 2015, these Pearson Tests include: *Assessment of Professional Knowledge: Early Childhood (PK-3) (Test #001) and Early Childhood Education (Test #012)*.

Foreign language requirement: For students pursuing Early Childhood (PK-3) licensure, the foreign language requirement is waived. If the student changes majors and drops licensure, the requirement is reinstated for that student.
